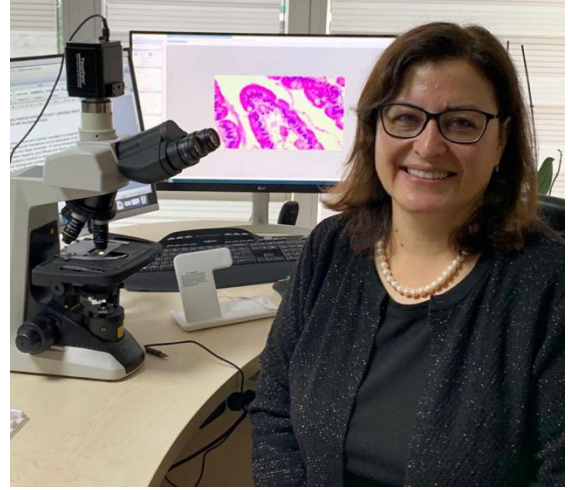


Who I Am



I was born in 1969 in Çankırı. I graduated from Hacettepe University Faculty of Medicine in 1993. In 1999, I have completed my Pathology specialty training at Hacettepe University and started to work as a lecturer at the same University. I studied breast pathology and molecular pathology at the *Institute of Cancer Research* in United Kingdom between 2001-2002 and at the *Thomas Jefferson University 'Kimmel Cancer Center* in the USA between 2003-2004. I have received the title of associate professor in 2005. I transferred to Yıldırım Beyazıt University Faculty of Medicine between 2011-2013 as a professor to participate in the establishment of Faculty of Medicine and the Pathology Department. I worked as Vice Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and the Head of the Department of Pathology at Yıldırım Beyazıt University, as well as the chairperson of affiliated Ankara Atatürk Training and Research Hospital Pathology Laboratory. I returned to Hacettepe University as Professor of Pathology in 2013. I was chairperson of Hacettepe University Scientific Research Projects Coordination Unit between 2013-2015. I have more than 100 scientific publications which received over 1500 citations so far. I am particularly interested in breast pathology, endocrine system pathology, gynecological pathology, gastrointestinal system pathology and cytopathology.

After years of hard work and strenuous studying, I began practicing as a professional Pathologist in October 2016 in **GG Pathology**. My extensive medical knowledge combined with an ongoing curiosity to learn about the latest trends define my success in the medical field.
